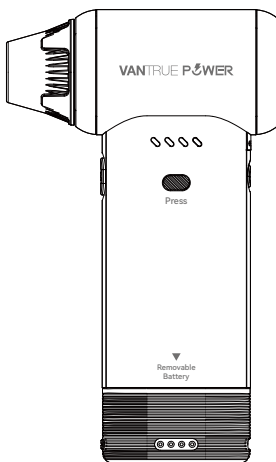

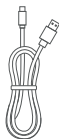

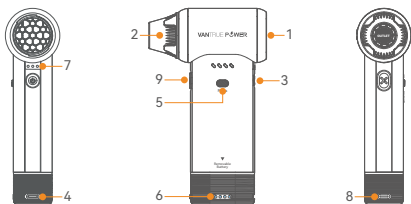

2. Product Structure Description



1. Air Inlet
2. Air Outlet
3. Power Button (Power on/off/Gear Switching)
4. Charging Port
5. Battery Removal Button
6. Power Indicator Light
7. Gear Indicator Light
8. Battery Level Button
9. Start Button

Note: The nozzle can only be attached to the air outlet marked with the "OUTLET" label. Do not install the nozzle on the air inlet, as doing so may draw in debris that could damage the fan blades, leading to equipment failure and safety hazards.

3. Operation Instructions

1) Power on/off

Press and hold the power button for 2 seconds to turn the device on or off. When powered on, the unit defaults to standby mode, during which no air output is delivered.

2) Gear Switching

The unit powers on at 3rd Gear (Turbine mode) by default. Briefly press the power button to cycle through the speed levels: 3rd Gear (Turbine Mode) → 2nd Gear (Strong Wind) → 1st Gear (Gentle Breeze).

3) Blowing Mode

- Manual mode: Press and hold the power button for continuous airflow; release the button to stop. (Only 3rd Gear is available in this mode.)
- Auto Mode: Press the power button once to start continuous airflow; press it again to stop. Please note that Auto mode supports 1st and 2nd Gear only – 3rd Gear (Turbine) is not available in this mode.

4) Battery Indicator Light

- Charging Status: The indicator lights flash in sequence to show the remaining battery level in real time.
- Fully Charged: All four indicator lights remain steadily lit.
- Low Battery: The four indicator lights flash to alert you to charge the device as soon as possible.
- The battery level is indicated by the number of lights illuminated: 4 lights = 100%, 3 lights = 75%, 2 lights = 50%, and 1 light = 25%.

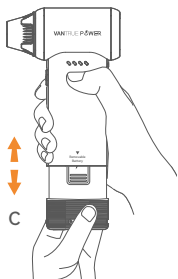
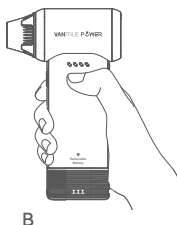
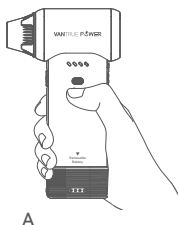
5) Charging Instructions

- Do not charge the device while it is in operation. Additionally, do not charge the device in high-temperature environments or leave it exposed to direct sunlight inside a vehicle.
- Avoid overcharging or over-discharging the battery, as this may shorten its lifespan. The device is equipped with an automatic shut-off protection that cuts off power when fully charged.

6) Auto Standby Protection

The device will automatically power off after 3 minutes of inactivity.

7) Battery Removal Steps



- a. Pick up the electric air duster .
- b. Press and hold the "**Press Button**" without releasing it.
- c. Remove the battery.

5. Safety Warnings

To reduce the risk of equipment malfunction, electric shock, personal injury, fire, death, and property damage, please strictly observe the following safety precautions.

1) Usage and Storage Specifications

- Do not block the air inlet or outlet while the device is in operation. Keep foreign objects out of the air duct to prevent damage to the unit.
- Do not immerse the unit in water.
- Do not use the device in damp environments. Keep the unit dry at all times.
- Never operate the device with wet hands.
- Do not use the device near flammable or explosive vapors, such as gasoline, paint thinner, or combustible sprays. Sparks generated by the motor

may ignite these gases, leading to fire or explosion.

- Do not leave the device unattended for extended periods while it is plugged in or charging, as overheating of the lithium battery may pose a fire risk.
- Do not store the device in high-humidity areas such as bathrooms or basements.
- Keep long hair, loose clothing, and scarves away from the air inlet to prevent them from being drawn into the fan and becoming entangled.
- Do not press or rub the air inlet or outlet with fingernails or sharp objects to avoid damaging the product.
- Do not clean the unit with alcohol, nail polish remover, corrosive organic solvents, or strong acid/alkali cleaners.
- Do not use the air inlet to pick up fine sand, gravel, or metal filings, as these may wear down the fan blades and clog the air duct.

2) Battery Safety

- Do not drop, strike, puncture, or disassemble the battery.
- Always use the supplied/approved charger to charge the battery.
- Keep the battery cells away from heat sources. Never throw the battery into fire.
- Do not overcharge, reverse-charge, or over-discharge the battery.
- Do not store the battery in a discharged state for extended periods. If the battery is to be left idle for more than 3 months, it is recommended to recharge it once a month.
- Do not mix with or use third-party/non-genuine batteries. Do not modify the battery.

3) Safety Precautions for Child Use

- This device is a power tool and is not a toy. Keep it out of the reach of infants and young children.
- Children must be under constant adult supervision when using this device. Do not allow children to play with it or point the airflow at faces or eyes.
- Do not allow children to disassemble the unit, battery, or accessories, as this may cause pinch injuries or electric shock.

4) Charging Cable Safety Specifications

- Do not use the charging cable if it is damaged or becomes hot during use, as this may cause short circuits, burns, electric shock, or fire.
- Do not plug in or unplug the charging cable with wet hands while charging.
- Do not bend, pull, step on, or place heavy objects on the charging cable. Such abuse may cause short circuits, leading to electric shock or fire.
- If the charging cable is damaged, it must be replaced with a new one.

5) Troubleshooting

- If the device exhibits any abnormal conditions such as no airflow, frequent shutdowns, overheating, or smoking, stop using it immediately. Continuing to operate a faulty device may cause short circuits, personal injury, or fire.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or repair the unit yourself. Please contact official after-sales service for assistance.
